



What is the cost of an Urgent Care visit?

If you have insurance:

Your personal cost will depend on whether we are in-network with your insurance plan, and your plan's co-pay, deductible, and coinsurance requirements.

We are in-network with most insurance plans, but you can confirm this by either asking our front desk staff or calling your insurance company.

If you don't have insurance:

The medical visit ranges from \$200 to \$355 depending on the complexity of your symptoms, and includes:

- vital signs, medication review, medical provider examination
- any rapid testing such as strep, flu, urine, and pregnancy (does not include COVID testing)
- any medication given during the visit

There could be additional costs for x-rays and advanced imaging, lab tests, and procedures, but your provider will discuss these with you before you are referred to additional services.

There is a **30% prompt pay discount** if your bill is paid in full within 30 days of your first statement date.

For those who need more time, the Hospital offers payment plans designed to fit the individual's ability to pay.
